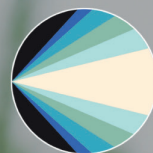

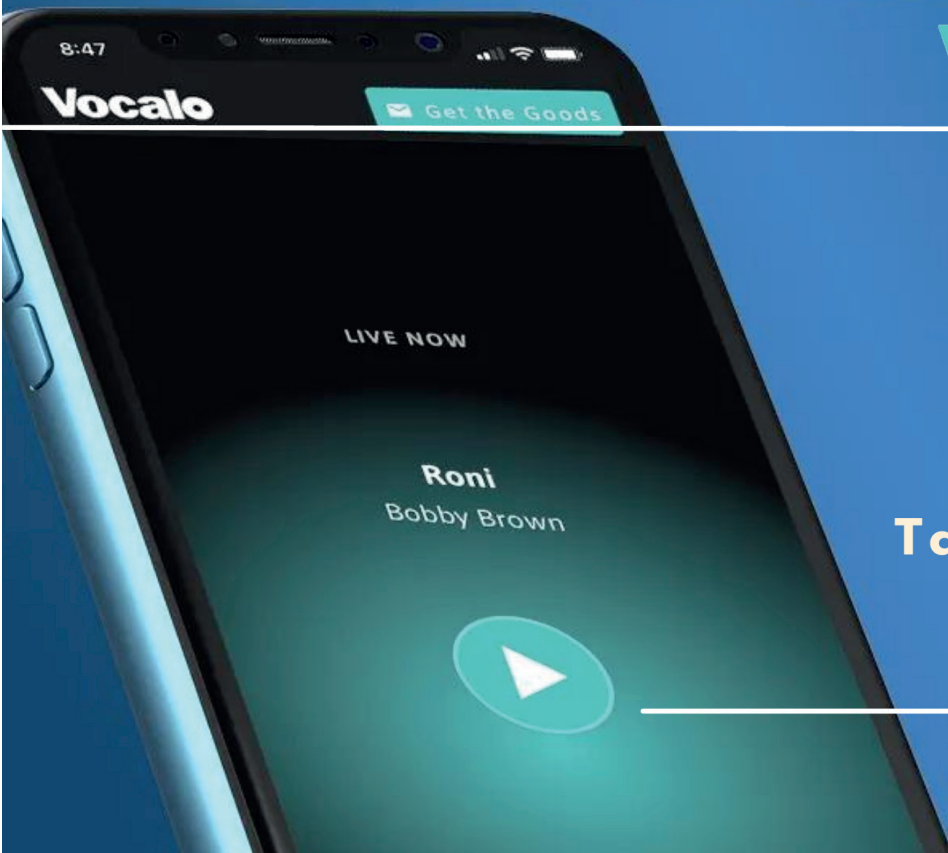

No Deal." focuses on the passing of one of the most progressive renewable energy bills in the nation, in the state of Illinois.
